Ed. teachers twice each week to focus on key components such as letter and sound recognition, rhyming word families, sight words, decoding strategies and reading comprehension all while developing an enjoyment of reading. Classrooms will be equipped with a listening station, leveled reading book bins, literacy games and appropriate take home activities.
